To provide an opportunity for youth and adults with disabilities and non-disabled youth and adults to develop connections around a common interest—HORSES!

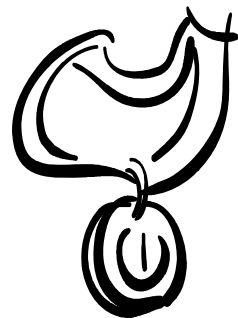
History and Past Success
